Before considering a training program complete, carriers can verify:

- ☐ 01 Training topics match identified safety risks
- ☐ 02 Drivers receive applicable HOS and ELD instruction
- ☐ 03 Fatigue risks are addressed
- ☐ 04 Vehicle inspection responsibilities are covered
- ☐ 05 Unsafe-driving behaviors are addressed
- ☐ 06 Company safety policies are explained
- ☐ 07 Training completion is documented
- ☐ 08 Follow-up monitoring is defined
- ☐ 09 Recurring problems trigger additional review
- ☐ 10 Training records are organized and accessible

Why it matters

FMCSA audits routinely cite incomplete or undocumented driver training as a compliance failure, and gaps like these can carry fines of \$10,000 or more per violation. A documented, monitored training program is what closes that exposure and holds up if your carrier is audited.
